**WILL SCOTT'S NEW ALBUM, *GNAWBONE*, TO BE RELEASED IN NEW YORK AT RODEO BAR, DEC. 11**  
*Renowned Americana and Alt. Blues artist Will Scott will officially release his new album, *Gnawbone*, in New York with a full-band performance at Rodeo Bar on December 11, 2009. Band support will be provided by Jim Whitney on Bass, Preacher Boy on keyboards, Wylie Wirth on drums, and various special guests.*

## BODY:

Acclaimed Brooklyn-based Americana, and Alt. Blues artist, WILL SCOTT, releases his debut studio project entitled, *Gnawbone*, at Rodeo Bar in New York City on December 11. The new album includes guest performances by Jolie Holland (ANTI- Records), Samantha Parton (The Be Good Tanyas), Jan Bell (Jan Bell & The Cheap Dates, The Maybelles), and the album's producer, Preacher Boy (Eagle Eye Cherry, Blind Pig Records).

Originally from Indiana, SCOTT has lived in New York since 2002, performing, when not on tour, at The Living Room, Union Pool, Jalopy and other venues. His weekly residency at 68 Jay Street Bar in DUMBO, running for over two years, is described by Lucid Culture as "the best weekly blues show in New York." On tour, SCOTT's energetic live performances have captivated crowds all over the US and England, leading to a recent debut performance at The Glastonbury Festival.

*Gnawbone* is receiving glowing reviews from the press and fans. Americana UK says "Will Scott's... recording draws on southern rock, blues and music akin to Jim Morrison of the Doors even, as he embraces everything that is good in Americana music... One of the most impressive new acts of his kind to come along in quite some time." Americana Roots proclaims "*Gnawbone* will catch your attention immediately with its hard driving soulful depth... a tantalizing CD."

*Gnawbone*'s first two tracks show SCOTT's Hoosier roots. Tom-Petty-styled rocker, "Jack's Defeat Creek," and slide-guitar romp, "Gnawbone," are both inspired by towns of the same names in southern Indiana. Additional highlights include "Make Her Love Me," a funky, Junior Kimbrough-inspired groove, "Stain Lifter," a hard-hitting song of contrition with a touch of Lanois-style production, and "Amen Corner," a meditation on dying made heart-breaking by Jolie Holland's devilish fiddle and the angelic backing vocals of Holland, Samantha Parton, and Jan Bell.

The CD release performance will begin at 10:30 p.m. on December 11, 2009, at Rodeo Bar, 375 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue (corner of 27<sup>th</sup> Street), New York, NY 10016. Rodeo Bar's phone number is (212) 683-6500.
